We are delighted to announce that the 32nd Annual Masters in the Mountains™ Invitational Golf Tournament will be held on Wednesday, September 2nd, 2026 at the Dorset Field Club in Dorset, VT. All proceeds benefit Southwestern Vermont Medical Center (SVMC).

The Dorset Field Club golf course, originally named Dorset Golf Links, was first laid out in 1886 and was small, with just nine holes that bore charming names like *Clover Patch* and *Home Willow Tree*. The original layout involved playing across roads, over hills, through swamps and pastures, and amid apple orchards, all on privately held land.

In the late 1890s, the course was extended and a clubhouse was built. The Dorset Golf Links name was soon replaced with the Dorset Field Club to better reflect its wide variety of recreational and sports activities.

Today, the course is 18 holes, and the club has the distinction of being regarded as the oldest continually operating golf club in its original location in the United States and one of the twenty-five oldest courses in the world! The latest update on the course includes expanding the distance of the first hole to 492 yards.

SVMC received **top marks** from Becker's Hospital Review as **one of the best hospitals in the country** for nurse and physician communication with patients.



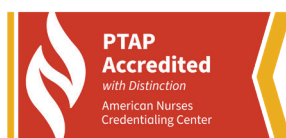
